The OPTREX schedule in detail.

May 24th final date for registering which GUARANTEES if you are completely ready, you will meet with a QE on June 19th subject to mandatory underway June 5th if applicable. If not completely ready, indicate any requirements that are not completed and your plan for completing them before June 6. Those who are COMPLETELY ready by May 24th and those with a believable plan for completing any remaining items will be tentatively scheduled to meet with the QE. Everyone else, including all registrations received after May 24 will be on the stand-by list. This date is selected to give the QEs time to check your records, to schedule their time, us to locate boats, etc.

June 5th boat familiarization, U/W practice and workshops. Under Way is mandatory for all initial applicants and all non-division 12 applicants; highly recommended for all applicants.

June 6th cut date for any applicants who have not completed or can not document ALL required training and the above mandatory U/W if applicable. Your FC and I must agree you are ready to QE. The applicants cut at this time from the June 19th OPTREX will be replaced by stand-by applicants who have completed and can document ALL required training. Any remaining completely ready applicants on stand-by MAY meet with a QE on June 19th ON A SPACE AVAILABLE BASIS.

GUIDE FOR COMPLETELY READY:

All tasks in the AUX Boat Crew Qualification Guide are to be signed off by a Mentor. The below tasks are included In the qualification guides for Crew, Coxswain and PWC Operator. These are the most frequently overlooked tasks that have to be accomplished prior to requesting a QE. All tasks are to be completed prior to requesting a QE.

The Flotilla Commander and the person requesting a QE (Roger Haynes in this OPTREX) are responsible to verify that all persons he/she submits to meet with a QE are properly prepared before a Qualified Examiner is requested. Therefore if the candidate plans to go to another Flotilla or a Division's event, the Flotilla Commander should pass all supporting documents (copies if desired, including signoff manual) to the person who will be verifying the quals at the event outside of the candidate's Flotilla level. The Division member will be requesting the Qualification Examiner(s).

Proficiencies both dockside and on the water; will be demonstrated for the QE's signature. If candidates come from more than one Flotilla please have all candidates' names on one form. *Only one form per QE session including all candidates and only one person should be requesting the QE's*
